
Upon receipt of the verification and Personal Property Listing forms, we will continue the investigation into this matter. I will immediately contact you once consideration is given to the listing forms and we

This letter will acknowledge our recent conversations in reference to the above captioned matter and also the additional Personal Property Inventory forms and supplemental information you had forwarded.


Consideration has now been given to the Personal Property you have listed as either being destroyed or stolen from your property.

This letter will acknowledge receipt of Personal Property Inventory forms forwarded by yourself on 10-19-79. In reference to these particular forms, I am at this time forwarding them back to your attention, as they are not comprehensively complete to a point where we are able to give adequate consideration to an equitable settlement of this matter.

It will be necessary that you supply us with the brand names, dates of purchase, original cost, etc. You will note that the Personal Property Inventory forms used by this company are self explanatory and go into detail as to the above-mentioned information necessary for completion of them.
